Welsh Ridden

Class 10 – Welsh Part-Bred Lead Rein

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cm. The rider not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies to be shown in snaffle bridle only and the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

Class 11 – Welsh Part-Bred First Ridden

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. The rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies must be shown in any suitable bridle.

Class 12 – Section A or B Lead Rein

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cm. The rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies to be shown in a snaffle bridle only and the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

Class 13 – Section A or B First Ridden

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. The rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Ponies must be shown in any suitable bridle.

Championship – 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 10 – 13 to compete

Class 14 – Open Ridden Section A – Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. No lead reins. 1st and 2nd will qualify.

Class 15 – Open Ridden Section B – Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. 1st and 2nd will qualify.

Class 16 – Open Ridden Section C – Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. 1st and 2nd will qualify.

Class 17 – Open Ridden Section D – Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. 1st and 2nd will qualify.

Class 18 – Registered Welsh-Part Bred – Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Any Height. 1st and 2nd will qualify.

1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 14 – 18 to compete for Ridden Championship
