NB - 1st and 2nd in classes 31 - 34 will qualify for the Brynseion Ridden Championships and in the event of either having already qualified, then the award will be passed to next eligible pony.

1st & 2nd class 35 will qualify for the Dengie Ridden WP-BR Championship

## Welsh Pony & Cob Society - Rules for Ridden Stallions

### (Please Note)

Sections A & B - Welsh Part-Bred 13.2hh and under- Riders must have attained their 12th birthday

Sections C & D - Welsh Part-Bred over 13.2hh - Riders must have attained their 14th birthday

## Rules

1. The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate/divide certain classes, if deemed appropriate
2. Numbers to be collected from the Secretary on the day of the Show
3. Entrees will not be confirmed unless SAE is enclosed
4. All entries to be registered in the Welsh Stud Book
5. The Judge's decision is final
6. All stallions exhibited must be in possession of current Ministry of Agriculture Licence or WPCS Licence
7. The exhibitor is responsible for ensuring that his, or her, exhibit is forwarded for judging at the correct time
8. Exhibitors are not permitted to enter any animal when that animal will be judged by a person who has bred, produced, or had any financial interest whatsoever in, the said animal
9. No manes or tails to be plaited
10. In ridden classes all animals must be 4 years old or over.
- 10a. Hard hats complying with **BS 447216473** or **PAS 015 Standard** must be worn by riders at **ALL times - when mounted**
11. No spurs allowed in ridden classes
12. No whip or cane to exceed 30 inches in ridden classes .
13. Exhibitors should ensure that they are adequately covered by Third Party Insurance
14. All trophies to remain the property of the Glamorgan Welsh Pony & Cob Association and must be signed for, and returned one month before the following Spring Show
15. The Organisers shall not be held responsible for anything that may happen through accident, or otherwise, to any person, exhibit, vehicle, trailer, or article brought to the Show

### **Supreme in-Hand Championship**

#### Welsh Ridden

Class 27 Welsh Part - Bred - lead rein - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cm. The rider not to have attained their 7th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies to be shown in snaffle bridle only and the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

Class 28 Welsh part - bred - first ridden - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. The rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies must be shown in any suitable bridle.

Class 29 Section A or B - lead rein - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cm. The rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies to be shown in snaffle bridle only and the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

Class 30 Section A or B - first ridden - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. The rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies must be shown in any suitable bridle.

**Championship - 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 27-30 to compete.**

Class 31 - Open Ridden Section A - stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over  
No lead reins. 1st and 2nd will qualify.

Class 32 - Open Ridden Section B - stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over  
1st and 2nd will qualify.

Class 33 - Open Ridden Section C - stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over  
1st and 2nd will qualify.

Class 34 - Open Ridden Section D - stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over  
1st and 2nd will qualify.

Class 35 - Registered Welsh Part Bred - stallion, mare or gelding 4 years old and over. Any height.

1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 31 - 35 to compete for **Supreme Ridden Championship**
